The Ministry of Justice and the Special Penitentiary Service of Georgia will host a High-Level Conference on the topic of **"Innovations in the Rehabilitation Process of Inmates and Probationers"** in Tbilisi on 1-3 November, 2023.

The High-Level Conference is organized in partnership with the U.S. State Department's Bureau of International Narcotics and Law Enforcement Affairs (INL) and the European Organization of Prison and Correctional Services (EuroPris). The Conference is devoted to reviewing the progress achieved in penal systems, with the special focus on the digital services applied in the systems, as well as educational, sport, art and other resocialization-rehabilitation programs.

The High-Level Conference will serve as a communication and partnership platform for constructive dialogue between the invited representatives from countries, international organizations, and experts, who will share their knowledge and experience in the field.
